



## **CNPD Faculty Innovative Summer Grant Development Award** **Office of Research & Grants Management**

### **Purpose:**

To bolster our college's applications for external grant funding for research and scholarship, Dean Shogren and the CNPD's Research and Scholarship Committee are pleased to announce funding to support summer work for faculty to collaborate and produce an interdisciplinary and/or innovative external grant application.

### **Deadlines:**

Summer Grant applications must be submitted no later than March 15<sup>th</sup> by 5 pm CT.

### **Funding:**

Three \$7,500 awards for compensation to work on an external grant submission. Please note that funds cannot be used to support salaries of faculty members in positions outside of the CNPD or travel.

1. Half of the funds will cover the work to prepare the grant proposal during the summer semester May 16, 2024 – August 15, 2024.
2. The second half of the funds will be awarded upon submission of the grant. Verification of grant proposal submission must be submitted to receive the second half of the funds. The deadline to submit the grant is 12-31-2024.

### **Eligibility:**

1. Two interdisciplinary \$7,500 awards:
  - a. If two CNPD faculty from different departments want to submit for one shared award, they will split the funding.
  - b. If one CNPD faculty plans to work with someone across campus or outside the University, the CNPD award can only cover the CNPD employee's salary; we cannot cover another department's faculty member.
2. One open \$7,500 award:
  - a. Not required to be interdisciplinary (but can be). Applicants must be two or more from the same or different UND departments or colleges or from outside the University.
3. Awards are open to all CNPD faculty (tenure, tenure track, and clinical) who have at least a 60% appointment with CNPD.

### **Timeline:**

1. Time period for receiving 50% of funding will be May 16, 2024, to August 15, 2024 for writing the grant proposal. The grant proposal must be prepared during these months.
2. The grant must be submitted in Novelution, by August 30, 2024.
3. Verification of grant submission to the funding agency by December 31, 2024 unless negotiated with the Dean.
